COMMITTAL ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT – 1 IN R.C.C. No. 402/2024
State Vs. Dattu

Today the accused Bashirkha Alikha Multani is appeared. The prosecution alleged that accused has committed offence p/u/s 328, 272, 273, 188 of the IPC. Section 328 of the IPC is exclusively triable by the Court of Session. The copies of police report and other documents as specified in Sec. 230 and Sec. 231 of the Bhartiya Nagik Suraksha Sanhita has been supplied to the accused person. I explained them the provisions of free legal aid available to them. However, he has not shown his desire to avail of free legal assistance. Further, he is going to make their own arrangement of defence before Hon'ble Sessions Court. Considering the nature of allegation, the case has to commit to the Court of Session. Hence, the order.

ORDER

- 1) The case be committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Yeola.
- 2) The accused directed to remain present before Hon'ble Court of Session, Yeola, on **21/04/2026**.
- 3) The record of the case, the documents and articles, which are to be produced in evidence, shall be sent to the Hon'ble Court of Session, Yeola.

- 4) The police station officer, Taluka Police Station be directed to produce muddemal property in the Hon'ble Court of Session Yeola, on or before **21/04/2026** positively.
- 5) The public prosecutor shall be notified of the commitment of the case of the Hon'ble Court of Session, Yeola.
