ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(State V/s Ramesh Balu Tanpure)

The present case is filed against the accused persons for the offence p/u/sec. 379 of I.P.C. The matter is kept in Lok-adalat. Today, the informant filed the pursis at Exh. 27 and compromise memo at Exh. 28 and intimated the court regarding his disinterest to proceed with this case.

2. The alleged offence p/u/sec. 379 is compoundable vide section 320 of Code of Criminal Procedure. This section empowers the compounding of offence. In the instant case, it appears that the informant voluntarily filed the pursis at Exh. 27 for compounding the offence. This shows that the informant lost his interest in this case and moreover, the offence being compoundable is well within purview of section 320 of Criminal Procedure code. Hence, it is necessary to acquit the accused u/sec. 320 (8) of Criminal Procedure code. Hence, I am inclined to pass following order.

ORDER

1. The case is hereby disposed of as compoundable.
2. The accused is hereby acquitted vide Section 320(8) of Criminal Procedure Code.
3. The seized muddemal i.e. Bajaj Discover No. MH-

15/BZ-1205 is already handover to its registered owner, it be kept with him.

4. Bail bond of accused are hereby cancelled.
