ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Despite repeated calls, the plaintiffs and defendants, along with their respective advocates, have remained absent. No application has been filed on record by any of the parties. On perusal of the record of the case and the roznama, it appears that the plaintiffs have not remained present for a considerable period and have failed to take any further steps to prosecute the suit. Issues were framed in the year 2018. Thereafter, certain amendments were carried out; however, subsequent to the said amendments, the plaintiffs have not taken any steps to proceed with the suit.

02. From the conduct of the plaintiffs, it is apparent that they have lost interest in prosecuting the present suit. The suit has remained pending for a substantial period without any progress attributable to the inaction of the plaintiffs. In these circumstances, the suit being old and pending without prosecution, it is kept for dismissal for default on the next date of hearing, if no steps are taken.
