Examination-in-chief for claimant by Shri. M.V. Maindad, Adv. :

1. I am serving at Civil Hospital, Dharashiv as a Medical Officer and Orthopedic Surgeon. I have done my M.B.B.S. M.S.(D.Orth.). On 18-06-2024, I have examined the patient Mrs.Rupali Amol Gund. The patient had come to my clinic for seeking the disability certificate. The patient had brought discharge card of Ashwini Sahakari Rugnalaya Solapur, city scan report, M.L.C. certificate with her. I have physically examined her and found that the patient was operated for perforation of jejunum. Scar marks were found on the whole abdomen. As per my physical examination she had difficulty for bending forward, difficulty for weight lifting, difficulty to stand for long time and she had weakness to both legs. She is unable to perform her work of preparation of cake and cookies. As per MOA guidelines, I have analyses 28% permanent disability to the said patient. The patient has a possibility of hernia in future.

2. Accordingly, I have issued disability certificate to the patient. The disability certificate now shown to me is the same and bears my signature. Its contents are true and correct. Disability certificate is marked at **Exh.41.**

Cross-examination for respondent No.1 by Shri.R.B. Jadhav :

3. Absent when called out, hence no cross-examination.

Cross-examination for respondent No.2 by Shri. A.A. Danve Adv.:

4. It is true to say that, I have not treated the patient after the accident. It is true to say that, after the issuance of disability certificate Exh.41 the patient had not come to me for any treatment. While examining the said patient I have not taken any X-ray. It is true to say that, the patient had come to me for the only purpose of procuring the disability certificate. It is true to say that, the patient has not sustained any type of fracture. It is true to say that, for treating the abdominal issue there are separate doctors. It is not true to say that, since there was injury on the abdomen no permanent disability certificate can be granted.

5. I have prepared the notes of the patient before issuing the disability certificate but today I have not brought the same. It is not true to say that, since the patient sustained injury on her abdomen, she had not sustained any

permanent disability. It is not true to say that, I have issued false disability certificate in compliance MOA guidelines.
