

Order below Exh.19 in RCA No.37/2024

1. The appellants filed this application for bringing the L.Rs. of deceased respondent No.17/5 Ratan Laxman Karwar on record by delay condonation.
2. Read application. Despite giving sufficient opportunity respondents failed to file reply. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the appellants.
3. I have considered the reasons as quoted in the application for causing delay in filing application for bringing legal heirs of the respondent No.17/5 Ratan Laxman Karwar on record. Those reasons are justifiable and genuine.
4. It appears from the record that, there is delay of 1 year, 11 months and 24 days in filing the present application to bring legal heirs on record on respondent No.17/5 Ratan Laxman Karwar. The delay caused is not intentional to bring on record the L.Rs. In order to give the fair opportunity to contest the matter on merits, it is desirable to bring the L.Rs. on record by condoning the delay and setting aside the abatement. Hence, following order :

ORDER

1. Application at Exh.19 is allowed.
2. The delay caused in filing the application for bringing the L.Rs., of respondent No.17/5 Ratan Laxman Karwar on record is hereby condoned on payment of cost Rs.1,000/- (Rs. One Thousand only) to respondents.

3. The appellants are directed to bring the L.Rs. of deceased respondent No.17/5 Ratan Laxman Karwar on record, and carry out the necessary amendment within two weeks from today.
4. The appellants are directed to supply copies of amended appeal memo.
