

Order below Exh.08 in Sessions Case No.90/2025
(CNR No.MHOS01-000494-2025)

This is the application filed by the accused-Vaibhav Chandrakant Lakal for grant of regular bail on the ground that, charge-sheet in the matter is already filed, accused is innocent and is falsely implicated by the informant. It is submitted by the accused that, the deceased sustained injuries in motor bike accident but taking the undue advantage of the death, the informant with dishonest intention to grab the property has falsely implicated the accused in the false crime. It is further submitted that, there is no evidence about involvement of the accused and the investigation is virtually completed. Accused prayed to release him on regular bail.

2. Prosecution has resisted the bail application by filing say at Exh.09 contending that, there is ample evidence against the accused and in the F.I.R. it is clearly mentioned that only to get immediate medical treatment at Sahyadri Hospital, Latur false history is given. It is submitted by the prosecution that, there are two eye witnesses about the involvement of the accused in the said crime. Considering the gravity of the offence, it is prayed for rejection of the bail application.

3. Heard the learned advocate for the accused and learned P.P. for the state. Both of them submitted in tune of their respective pleadings.

4. It is the case of the prosecution that, on 31-08-2025 the informant-Pramod Lakal who was residing along with his father Chandrakant Lakal and brother i.e. the accused and their married

sister who had come at his home were sleeping in the night as usual after evening dinner. The father of the informant i.e. Chandrakant Lakal was sleeping in another room. At around 10.45 p.m., the informant heard shouts of his sister hence he went out and say that Vaibhav Lakal i.e. the accused was assaulting Chandrakant by wooden handle of the spade. Informant and his sister intervened and took the spade from the hand of the accused and saw that there father had got grievous injury on the right side of his head and the blood was oozing out of it. When the informant confronted with the accused about his act, the accused told that as his father Chandrakant was asking the accused not to follow Rampal Maharaj hence the accused had attacked on his father. It is further stated in the F.I.R. that, they took their father for treatment at Sahyadri Hospital, Latur. There, in order to get immediate medical treatment they had told that their father had fallen from the motorbike. On 05-08-2025 as the health of Chandrakant deteriorated he was shifted to the government hospital at Latur. There the informant had told that his brother had attacked on his father. Chandrakant succumbed to the injuries on 07-08-2025. Thereafter, on 09-08-2025 present F.I.R. came to be registered.

5. I have perused the charge-sheet before me. Prima-facie there are two eye witnesses and their statements are recorded. Both the statements are consistent regarding the involvement of the present accused. Prima-facie the alleged delay caused is the matter of trial. Considering the gravity of the matter I am not inclined to consider the bail application of the accused. Hence, the following order is passed :

ORDER

Application (Eh.08) stands rejected.
