Examination-in-chief for State by APP Shri. J. V.Deshmukh

1. In the year 2016 I was serving as male nurse at Civil Hospital, Osmanabad. I know panch No.2 Dhanaji Jadhav. He is my colleague. On 30.06.2016 I as well as Dhanaji Jadhav was called at ACB office. Our administrative officer directed us to attend that office for confidential work. We met Dy.S.P.Gawade. He introduced the complainant Nasir Nurulla Chaudhari. He asked us to verify and ensure whether his oral complaint and the written complainant are one and the same. Accordingly we panchas verified and ensured. Accordingly we signed on it. The complaint vide Exh.23 is now shown to me. It bears my signature, signature of Dhanaji Jadhav and Gawadesaheb. It also bears signature of the complainant. The complainant had also produced the copy of his identity card and copy of his application for earned leave. He also produced the copy of office order dt. 15.06.2016. We panchas and Gawadesaheb signed all these documents. Those are now shown to me. Those are same. Those are at **Exh.42 to 44**.

2. Thereafter Gawadesaheb took 4GB memory card and inserted it in the voice recorder. He ensured before us that it is blank. Thereafter the voice of complainant, Gawadesaheb and we panchas was recorded in it. Gawadesaheb directed his staff member to keep

the articles required for trap in Tata sumo vehicle. Accordingly ultraviolet lamp, sealing material, digital voice recorder, envelopes, black board, scanner etc. were kept in the vehicle. Thereafter Gawadesaheb, staff member and Dhanaji Jadhav sat in the Tata sumo. Myself and Nasir Chaudhari proceeded on Herohonda splendor motorcycle towards Tuljapur. First we left the office and after sometime the Jeep left at about 10.30.

3. The Jeep stop near Sub-district Hospital, Tuljapur. We also reached there in order to verify the complaint. Gawadesaheb switched on the voice recorder and placed it to the left pocket of the shirt of Nasir Chaudhari. Myself and Chaudhari went on a motorcycle near old Bus stand Tuljapur. From there we went to M.S.E.D.C.L. office. Nasir Chaudhari gave phone call to Rajendra Gadade. Rajendra Gadade said Nasir Mulla to give Rs.1000/- for sanctioning his earned leave for 10 days and for release order and for obtaining signature of seniors on it. Thereafter myself and Nasir Chaudhari went to meet Rajendra Gadade. We met him at Datta Raswanti Graha at Tuljapur. Nasir Chaudhari gave a register to Rajendra Gadade. Nasir Chaudhari asked Rajendra Gadade to make recommendation for sanctioning his leave. Rajendra Gadade informed Nasir Chaudhari that the senior has demanded an amount of Rs.1000/- to sanction the leave and to sign the relieve order. Chaudhari told Rajendra Gadade that he will go to ATM and bring the amount of Rs.1000/-.

4. Thereafter myself and Nasir Chaudhari came near the Tatasumo vehicle. Gawadesaheb switched off the voice recorder. Gawadesaheb asked me and Nasir Chaudhari as to what happened there. He informed that he will verify the voice recorder and will take further action. Thereafter Gawadesaheb took search of the person of Nasir Chaudhari. In the said search an amount of Rs.1220/- was

found, in which the two currency notes of denomination of 500 and two currency note of Rs.100/- and one currency notes of denomination of Rs.20/- was found. He was also found in possession of handkerchief and motorcycle key. The Gawadesaheb kept aside two currency notes of Rs.500/- and he kept the remaining currency notes and other articles in the left pocket of his pant.

5. We two panchas saw the serial numbers of the two currency notes of denomination of Rs.500/- and Gawadesaheb wrote those numbers on one blank paper. Thereafter Gawadesaheb asked we two panchas and Chaudhari to shift in Tatasumo vehicle. The window glasses of the vehicle were closed. Thereafter the demonstration of use of anthracene powder was shown to us in the light of ultraviolet lamp and it's characteristics were disclosed. One of the staff member of ACB applied anthracene powder to the two currency notes of denomination of Rs.500/-. Those were checked under the ultraviolet lamp by covering a black clothe and those were found shining. The said staff member kept those currency notes in right pocket of the pant of informant. The staff member was asked to wash and clean his hands by soap. Accordingly he washed his hands.

6. The hands of said staff member of ACB was checked under ultraviolet lamp. Those were not found shining. Thereafter the hands of both panchas, informant and staff member were checked under ultraviolet lamp and those were not found shining.

Further examination-in-chief is differ due to court time is over.
