Resumed on Solemn affirmation today -

Further examination-in-chief by P.P. Shri. S.B. Jadhavar continued -

7 Mr. Gavade give instructions to the complainant and the panchas. He instructed that after demand and after delivery of bribe, the complainant Naseer Chourdhari shall give signal by removing handkerchief from the left pocket of his pant and wipe his face. I was instructed to accompany complainant Naseer and watch the incident. I was also instructed that if complainant Naseer failed to give signal, I shall give signal by removing handkerchief from the left pocket of my pant and wipe my face. It was instructed second panch Shri. Jadhav to stay him at some distance and to observe the incident and if required, to give signal. Mr. Gavade informed his staff members to stay near by and after receiving signal, to arrive on the spot of incident. Mr. Gavade and his staff members stayed at Tata Sumo vehicle with the articles of trap and he asked complainant Naseer and me to go on his Hero Honda motorcycle near Juice centre (Raswanti Gruha). Before that Mr. Gavade switched on voice recorded on the left packet of shirt of complainant Naseer.

8 Myself and complainant Naseer went near Datta Raswanti Gruha which were near bus stand. Thereafter Mr. Gavade and his staff followed us and stayed at opposite side of Datta Raswanti Gruha. Thereafter complainant Choudhari telephoned one unknown person but the said person did not came. Complainant Choudhari again telephoned him. Thereafter Shri. Gadade came

there. There was talk between them. One Pan stall was nearby. We all went there by walk. When we reached near Pan Stall, complainant Naseer asked to Shri. Gadade as to what happened of his work. Gadade said that he has forwarded his leave application and relieve order to his seniors and he shall pay Rs.1000/- as said by his senior. Thereafter complainant Choudhari removed money from his right pocket of his pant and gave it to Gadade. Gadade received that amount and counted it. There were two currency notes of denomination of Rs.500/- each. Gadade kept those two currency notes of denomination of Rs.500/- in his left pocket of his shirt. Thereafter, as instructed, the complainant Choudhari removed handkerchief from the left pocket of his pant, wiped his face and gave signal. After receiving signal Shri. Gavade and his team reached near. Shri.Gavade immediately took Choudhari to one side, removed the voice recorder from his pocket and switched it up.

9 Shri.Gavade asked me who demanded the bribe and who received it. Thereafter, I pointed towards Gadade and informed that he demanded the bribe and received it. Thereafter, two ACB personnel caught both the wrists of Shri. Gadade. Shri. Gavade asked Shri.Gadade about his identity. He disclosed his name Rajendra Gadade. He also narrated his place of service as Kati Sub-station of MSEDCL. Thereafter Shri.Gavade instructed to second panch. As per his instruction, the second panch removed two notes from the left pocket of shirt of Shri.Gadade.

Further examination-in-chief is differ due to court time is over.
