1. This application is filed by respondent no. 3 for giving him opportunity to cross examine applicant, whose evidence affidavit is at Exh. 12. It is alleged by respondent no. 3 that some important documents were not received and advocate for this respondent was engaged in another court. 3. As there is no written defends by respondent no. 3, he shall restrict his cross-examination to the applicant to the extent of law point only.
