This petition having been finally heard on 09/07/2025 and the court on the same day delivered the following :-

JUDGMENT

1. This petitioners are Christians governed by the Indian Divorce Act.
2. Petitioners pray to dissolve their marriage solemnized on 30/10/2014 at St.Albert Church, Muthiyavila, Neyyar Dam Road, Kattakada as per Christian rites and ceremonies on the ground that their marriage is irretrievably broken.
3. Petitioners filed affidavit from which I am satisfied that their marriage is irretrievably broken and that there is no chance for a reunion. They stated that there is no chance for them to lead a happy married life. They are living separately from 28/12/2021 onwards.
4. When the matter came up for consideration, after the statutory period of six months, this court enquired the parties about the possibility of a reunion.
5. In the above circumstances, I allow this petition and declare that the marriage between the petitioners solemnized on 30/10/2014 at St.Albert Church,

Muthiyavila, Neyyar Dam Road, Kattakada, stands dissolved with effect from today.
