Neminath & Ors. ..V/s.. Sujit & Ors.

This is an application filed by defendant No.1 for setting aside the “No W.S.” order passed against him.

- 2) Heard Ld. counsel for defendant No.1 Shri. P. K. Kothawale and Ld. counsel for plaintiff Shri. S. N. Kawale.
- 3) Perused the application, say and record.
- 4) The record of the present case discloses that suit summons was duly served to defendant No.1. Despite that he failed to file his written statement within stipulated period and thereby “No W.S.” order dt. 08/12/2025 was passed.
- 5) The Ld. counsel for defendant No.1 vehemently submitted that due to unavailability of necessary documents and marriage ceremony of his son he could not file his written statement. It is necessary to mention here that the present suit is for perpetual injunction. Hence, to decide the matter on merit and to have fair opportunity by imposing costs it is proper to set aside the “No W.S.” order. The present application is supported by the written statement of the defendant No.1. Thus, in the interest of justice and to have fair trial, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed subject to costs of Rs. 300/- to be payable to the plaintiffs.
2. The written statement be read and recorded on payment of costs.
