**Evidence U/sec 299 of Cr.PC.**

I was working at District Hospital Dharwad during 2020 on contractual basis.

2. On 30- September 2020 at about 6.25 pm an injured by name Muktumhusen Hirekumbi came with the history of assault along with his relatives. On examination of the said injured the following injuries were noticed on the person of the said injured,.

1. There was a Cut lacerated wound over left fronto temporal area measuring 7 x 2 cms.
2. There was a lacerated wound over occipital area measuring 15x7x2 cms.
3. There was a Cut lacerated wound behind left ear measuring 5 x 1 cms.

4. There was a cut lacerated wound over left occipital area measuring 5x1 cms.

3. After suturing the wound and giving primary treatment in view of head injury the injured was referred to KIMS , hospital Hubballi. On verification of CT scan taken at KIMS hospital it is learnt that there was left temporo parietal bone fracture. right parietal bone fracture and subdural and subarachnoid haemorrhage. In view of the above report I am of the opinion that the above mentioned injuries are grievous in nature and fresh. I have issued wound certificate to that effect. The said wound certificate is identified by the witness is marked as Ex.P- 13 and signature of the witness as Ex.P- 13 [a].

4. On 11<sup>th</sup> October 2021 Police came with a weapon in sealed cover. On opening the seal it was found that it was a sharp edged wooding handled mache measuring in total 16 inches and 12 inches of blade. On examining the same I have furnished my opinion that the injuries mentioned in the wound certificate could be caused by this weapon. The said opinion letter identified by the witness is marked as Ex.P- 14 and signature of the witness as Ex.P- 14 [a]. The witness has identified M.O.1 before the court. After examination the weapon was again sealed and sent back to the police.

**Cross examination: As the witness is examined U/sec 299 of Cr.PC cross examination is treated as Nil.**
