01. Since 16.03.2018 I was working as Medical Officer at Primary Health Center Iet, Tal. Bhoom, Dist. Osmanabad. On 30.04.2018 at about 8:50 pm, patient name Meghraj Jagat Patil was come with his wife Kirti Meghraj Patil for medical examination. They stated about the physical injury caused on the head to the Meghraj Patil. Accordingly, I have examined him. I found the contusion injury to the patient hence, I referred him to the Osmanabad Civil Hospital. After that police have filed the city scan report of the patient. I have verified the city scan report. In city scan report, I found the right parietal bone of skull(fracture) hence, I mentioned the nature of injury is grievous hurt in medical certificate. After that I have issued medical certificate.

Cross-examination by advocate Mr. S.H.Mogal for accused on oath:-

03. Since 2018, I am working in medical field. It is true to say that, it is necessary to mention the MLC number and date of examination on the city scan report and other medical documents. It is true to say that, upon the city scan report MLC number and date of MLC are not written in the specific column. It is true to say that, documents filed by the police are all xerox copies. It is true to say that, I have personally not examined whether the xerox copies of documents filed by the police are issued by the Government Hospital Osmanabad or not. It is not true to say that, contusion is one type of injury and fracture is another type of injury. It is true to say that, if the skull is cracked then it can be said that fracture is caused to the patient. It is true to say that, at the time of issuing medical certificate I have not issued it with the covering letter. It is true to say that, this type of injury can be possible, if someone is falls from the surface upon the wall. It is not true to say that, I have deposed false in chief examination that, they stated about the physical injury caused on the head to the Meghraj Patil. It is not true to say that, whatever I deposed in my chief examination, I have deposed false. It is not true to say that, I have issued the false medical certificate below Exh.70 to the patient.
