ORDER :

Heard on an application u/o 39 Rule 1 & 2 CPC, for grant of ad interim injunction. The plaintiff has sought the relief to restraining the defendants from aliening, selling, transferring, mortgaging and from creating any third party interest or changing the nature of the suit property, as fully detailed in the headnote of the plaint.

The plaintiff has placed on record documents i.e. copy of Adhar card of the plaintiff, certified copy of jamabandi for the year 2022-2023, agreement to sell dated 20.05.2026, copy of bank statement of plaintiff, copy of google pay receipts, copy of Aadhar holder consent form of the plaintiff, etc.

Heard. From the perusal of the abovesaid documents, at this stage in order to curtail the multiplicity of proceedings and to protect the property in dispute it is desirable that the defendants be restrained from selling, transferring, encumbering, mortgaging and from creating any third party rights over the suit property, as detailed in the headnote of plaint till the final decision of the present case.

Compliance of order 39 rule 3 CPC be also made otherwise stay granted will stand vacated automatically and notice be issued to defendants for **31.08.2026** through ordinary manner as well through registered post, process fees, copies of plaint, registered cover. Dasti summons be also issued in addition to ordinary process.
