Heard. At this stage, I am prima facie satisfied about existence of sufficient grounds for proceeding against the accused for offences under Sections 353/186/510 IPC. Hon'ble Supreme Court has held in 'State of Orrisa and another Vs Saroj Kumar Sahu' 2006 (1) RCR (Criminal) 324 that.

“At this stage of framing charge, court has to only prima facie be satisfied about existence of sufficient grounds for proceedings against the accused.”

A separate charge sheet for offences under Sections 353/186/510 IPC, against the accused has been served accordingly, to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial. Now, witnesses of prosecution be summoned for 19.11.2014.
