ORDER BELOW EXH.1**(Passed on 05.06.2026)**

1] This is application seeking regular bail moved by the present accused-applicant under Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (for short B.N.S.S.) 2023, in Crime No. 187/2026 registered with Paranda Police Station, Dist. Osmanabad for the offences punishable under Sections 311 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (for short B.N.S.).

2] Prosecution case set out against the accused-applicant is as follows:

The informant Sou. Lata Vishwanath Jagtap, resident of Kumbheja, Tq. Paranda, Dist. Dharashiv, at present r/o. Sy. No. 9/1, Ramkrushna Nagar, near Mangal Karyalaya, Onkar Colony, Pimple Gurav, Pune lodged complaint with Paranda Police Station alleging that on 25.04.2026 at about 12:30 p.m. while she and her husband were slept in the courtyard in front of their house, five unknown persons came with the intention to rob them. Out of them two persons stood watching out of the house and one of the accused snatched golden ganthan from the neck of the informant forcibly by raising sugarcane cutter sickle on her. Other two accused persons demanded gold and cash amount from the husband of the informant but as husband of the informant refused the accused persons beat him by knife and

caused grievous injury to him.

3] On the basis of the above said statement of victim FIR came to be registered for the offences referred above.

4] Accused-applicants were apprehended on 26.04.2026 and produced before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Paranda. The J.M.F.C. Paranda remanded the accused persons to the police custody till 02.05.2026. On 02.05.2026 the J.M.F.C. Paranda remanded the accused persons to the Magisterial Custody and since then accused persons are in the Magisterial Custody.

5] According to the applicants, they are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged. The complaint is lodged against unknown persons, so there is no any concerned of the present accused with the alleged crime. The police have arrested the accused persons only on the suspicion. Applicants are law abiding person, they never tried to commit any offence as alleged and report lodged by informant is totally false and based on imaginary grounds. The name of these applicants are not mentioned in F.I.R. as same is registered against the unknown person. If ever there would be any relation of applicant with crime in question then informant would lodge report by mentioning name of these applicants, which creates no credibility about prosecution story. There are no criminal antecedents of the accused persons. The custodial interrogation of the accused-applicants is not necessary. Accused-applicants are permanent resident of village Anala, Tq. Paranda, Dist.

Dharashiv and having movable and immovable property, so they will not abscond. Accused-applicants are Karta of their family and their family are depend upon them. Hence, it is prayed that accused-applicants may grant regular bail.

6] Prosecution has opposed the application by filing say at Exh.5 and 6. It is contended that the accusations are serious. Investigation is in progress. As the injured witness Vishwanath Jagtap is under treatment, the identification parade of the accused-applicants has not carried out till today. Taking into consideration the record of the accused-applicants if they are released on bail there will be danger to the life of informant, witnesses and panch. The accused-applicants are criminal in nature. There is every possibility that the applicant will hamper the investigation which is in progress. Custodial interrogation of the applicants is thus necessary. If regular bail is granted to the applicants they will pressurize the informant, injured and prosecution witnesses and will intimidate them. It is thus prayed that the application seeking regular bail be rejected.

7] The informant also intervened and opposed the bail application by filing say at Exh.10 by reiterating the accusations and much or less on the grounds on which the prosecution has opposed the bail.

8] Heard Mr. S.R.Sonmali, learned advocate for the applicants, Mr. P.P. Gade, the learned A.P.P. for the State and Mr.A.S.Jagtap learned advocate for the informant.

9] The injured Vishwanath Jagtap is still hospitalized with Military Southern Command Hospital, Pune being diagnosis penetrating abdomen injury with jejunal perforation, mesenteric tear and left sided hemopneumothorax left, 8th posterior rib fracture (OPTD). To be more specific its life threatening injury. The applicants dared to assault an Ex-serviceman. The applicants have suppressed their criminal antecedents and that they are history sheeters.

10] The accusations are serious. Investigation is still in progress. No charge-sheet has been filed so far. There is every possibility that the applicants owing to that criminal antecedents will intimidate the prosecution witnesses and the informant, will tamper with the evidence and hamper the investigation. At this stage it is not a fit case to grant pre-arrest bail as the possibility of abusing the liberty cannot be ruled out. Hence, I am not inclined to allow the prayer and accordingly proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Criminal Bail Application No. 89/2026 seeking regular bail, is hereby rejected.
