ORDER BELOW EXH.44
(CNRNO.MHOS190013902025)

1. The Decree Holder has filed the present application praying that the amount of Rs. 76,81,488/- lying in the bank account of the Judgment Debtor No. 2 which has already been attached pursuant to the orders passed by this Court, be called upon.
2. Perused the application and say. Hd. the Ld. advocate for both the sides.
3. Perusal of record reveals that, the bank account of the Judgment Debtor No. 2 has already been attached in execution of the decree. The attachment order continues to remain in force. There is nothing on record to show that the attachment has been vacated, stayed, or modified by any higher court. The Judgment Debtor has also failed to point out any legal impediment for calling of the attached amount to this Court.
4. The purpose of attachment before realization is to secure satisfaction of the decree. Once the attachment has been effected and no valid objection survives, the attached amount deserves to be called from the garnishee bank and deposited in this Court so that further appropriate orders towards satisfaction of the

decree can be passed.

5. Thus, taking into consideration the above facts, this court is satisfied that the amount lying in the attached account of J.D. No. 2 is warranted to be called upon for the enforcement of the decretal amount. However, as this court is newly established and does not has a separate PDA (Personal Deposit Account) it is necessary to give directions to the concerned Bank Manager to deposit the amount in the account of Civil Judge Senior Division, Osmanabad. In view of the above, I proceed to pass the following order:- :-

ORDER

1. The application at Exhibit 44 is hereby allowed.
2. The Branch Manager of State Bank of India, Mangalwar Peth Tuljapur Branch, is directed to transfer the amount of Rs. 76,81,488/- lying in the attached account of the Judgment Debtor, bearing Account No.62134197957 to the account of Civil Judge Senior Division, Osmanabad for satisfaction of decretal amount.
3. Parties to take note.
4. Issue letter to the concerned bank manager accordingly with direction to follow the order scrupulously.
