others**Versus**State of Maharashtra,
Through Police Station Kotwali,
Parbhani

ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(Passed on 12.06.2026)

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS for releasing applicants / accused (i) Shaikh Afroz Shaikh Gaffar, (ii) Safiyabi Shaikh Gaffar, (iii) Shaikh Gaffar Shaikh Ahmed, (iv) Sanabi Amirkhan, (v) Sumayabi Kalim Ahmed Ansari, (vi) Saba Shaikh Mohammad, (vii) Shahin Begum Shaikh Mustafa and (viii) Nazema Shaikh Jabbar, on bail in the event of arrest in **Crime No.252/2026** for offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 3(5), 85, 352, 351(2) of BNS registered with Kotwali Police Station, Parbhani.

2. Heard learned Counsel for applicants/accused and learned APP for the State. It is case of prosecution that informant is wife of accused No.1 Shaikh Afroz. Their marriage solemnized on 19/5/2025. Remaining accused No.2 to 8 are relatives of her husband. Accused have given him good treatment for a period of one month. On 20/6/2025 at about 10.00 hours, her parents-in-law have abused her in filthy words by saying that she is not looking good, she is fat and she is not able to do proper household work. So also, they stated that her parents have not given any dowry in the marriage. Thereafter, they started to harass/ill-treat the informant. Accused Sanabi, Sumayabi, Sababi are sisters of her husband. They were provoking the husband of informant to ill-treat/harass her. They were saying that she should give divorce to their brother and they want to perform his marriage with another girl.

They were also abusing the informant in filthy words and were also saying that she is fat.

3. Informant further alleged that cousin mother-in-law Shahin Shaikh and Najma Shaikh also ill-treating and harassing the informant in the same way. They were also asking the informant to bring Rs.1,00,000/- from her brother to make big their hotel. For that purpose, they were beating the informant by fist and kicks. Their relatives have tried to give understanding and settle the matter, but in-vain. In December 2025 at about 11.00 pm accused have drove her out of house and since then she is residing at her parents house. Thereafter, on 23/2/2026 she has given complaint in Bharosa Cell, S.P. office, Parbhani. Thereafter, meeting was held between accused and informant. However, accused remained absent for next meetings and hence, matter could not settle.

4. Learned counsel for applicants/accused argued that there are general allegations against accused. No specific role is attributed to each accused in the FIR. Accused No.4 to 6 are sisters of husband of informant and they are residing at their marital house. Accused No.7 and 8 are cousin mother-in-laws and they are also residing separate from accused No.1. The informant arrayed them only to harass. Custodial interrogations with applicants is not necessary. Applicants will abide every condition if released on anticipatory bail.

5. As per say of prosecution and argument of learned APP, accused participated in only one meeting in Bharosa Cell at S.P. office, Parbhani and thereafter, remained absent. Thus, parties could not arrived at settlement. The accused have physically and mentally harassed the informant by demanding money for the purpose of hotel

business. They have driven the informant in the night hours. Their custodial interrogation is necessary.

6. Taking into consideration rival contention of parties, it seems that nothing is to be recovered/seized from the accused. Accused No.1 is husband of informant. Accused No.2 to 8 are relatives of her husband. Accused No.4 to 8 are residing separate from accused No.1. Accused have no criminal antecedent. Considering nature of offence and above facts, it is desirable to release applicants on anticipatory bail on certain conditions. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Cri. Bail Application No. 461/2026 is allowed as under.
2. Applicants / accused **(i)** Shaikh Afroz Shaikh Gaffar, **(ii)** Safiyabi Shaikh Gaffar, **(iii)** Shaikh Gaffar Shaikh Ahmed, **(iv)** Sanabi Amirkhan, **(v)** Sumayabi Kalim Ahmed Ansari, **(vi)** Saba Shaikh Mohammad, **(vii)** Shahin Begum Shaikh Mustafa and **(viii)** Nazema Shaikh Jabbar, be released on bail in the event of arrest in **Crime No.252/2026** for offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 3(5), 85, 352, 351(2) of BNS registered with Kotwali Police Station, Parbhani; subject to conditions:
 - i) Applicants shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.75,000/- each with one or more sureties in the like amount.
 - ii) Applicants shall not tamper with any of the prosecution witnesses, directly or indirectly.
 - iii) Applicants shall remain present in concerned police station on every Tuesday between 10.00 am to 1.00 pm for a period of

one month or till filing of charge-sheet whichever is earlier.

iv) Applicants shall co-operate in investigation and make themselves available for investigation whenever required by I.O. till filing of charge-sheet.

v) Applicants shall not misuse their liberty.

vi) Applicants shall furnish their detail address and mobile number to the investigation officer and the concerned court. In case applicants change their residence/address and mobile number, they shall furnish the same to the I.O and concerned court.

vii) Applicants shall furnish names, detail address and mobile number of their three close/blood relatives.

3. Inform to learned trial court and concerned Police Station.
