CRIMINAL BAIL APPLICATION NO. 467/2026

Shahista Abdul Raheman Vs. State

[Passed on 23th June, 2026]

Accused – applicant Shahista W/o. Abdul Raheman has filed this bail application under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Cr.No.164/2026 registered at Police Station Bori, Tq. Jintur, Dist. Parbhani for offence punishable under Sections 11, 5(B), 3(5), 6, 9 of the Maharashtra Animal Preservation Act, 1976.

02. The prosecution case, in short, is that police constable Prakash More along with other police staff was patrolling in the area of village Kausadi Bit. They received secret information that Abdul Raheman Abdul Karim Qureshi and his wife i.e. applicant-accused Shahista were cutting cow. Hence, he effected raid before two panchas. One cow and one bull and some other bulls were found in possession of the accused. They seized the cattles and Tata company vehicle.

03. On the aforesaid report the crime came to be registered against accused the accused for the offences mentioned above.

04. It is contention of the accused that she has no any concerned with the alleged offence. Nothing was seized from her.

The offences are not punishable for life imprisonment or death penalty. Merely because she was present at house she has been involved in this crime. She is ready to assist I.O. for investigation. She resides within jurisdiction of this Court. She will not abscond or tamper or hamper with the prosecution evidence. She prayed to grant her anticipatory bail.

05. Resisting the application Ld. APP in his say at Exh. 5 has submitted that the accused and her husband engaged in cutting of bulls and cow. He submitted that on seeing police the accused and her husband ran away. They are absconding. By arresting them investigation is to be made. He prayed to reject the application.

06. Advocate of the accused submitted that the alleged muddemal came to be seized. Now nothing is to be seized from the accused. The applicant-accused is wife of Abdul Raheman. Custody of the accused is not required. He prayed to grant anticipatory bail. On the other hand, Ld. APP Mr. Giram has submitted that anticipatory bail may be granted by imposing conditions. Hence, I pass the following order.

Order

1	The application is allowed.
2	In the event of arrest of applicant-accused Shahista W/o. Abdul Raheman she shall be released on P.B. of Rs.25,000/- and surety in the like amount in connection with Cr.No.164/2026 registered at Police Station Bori, Tq. Jintur, Dist. Parbhani for offence punishable under Sections 11, 5(B), 3(5), 6, 9 of the Mharashtra Animal Preservation Act, 1976, with condition that -

	1) She shall attend the concern police station during 10.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m. on every Sunday for one month if called by I.O.
	2) She shall assist the investigating officer for investigation.
	3) She shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.
	4) She shall not hamper or tamper with the prosecution evidence.
	5) She shall not go abroad without permission of the investigating officer, till filing charge-sheet.
3	Inform to concern police station accordingly.
