

Matter referred to Lok Adalath.
The guardian of the petitioner, her
uncle present. Respondent No.3
counsel present.

The guardian is identified by the
petitioner counsel.

The matter was conciliated
previously and today a joint memo is
filed by petitioner and respondent
No.3, insurance company stating that
the claim of the petitioner is settled
for a total sum of Rs.25,000/-.

On enquiry the guardian of the
petitioner submits that the minor
petitioner has lost both her parents.
That even the grandparents on both
the paternal and maternal side are
dead and that he is looking after the
child. He states that he is agreeable
to the said settlement. The petitioner
counsel files his certificate with
application U/O 32 Rule 7 of CPC
stating that the settlement is in the
interest of the minor petitioner.

The settlement reached at
appears to be voluntary. Hence, the
joint memo is accepted. The petition is
disposed off as settled with
intervention of Lok Adalath.

The entire deposited amount
shall be kept as FD in the name of
minor petitioner till she attains the
age of 21 years.

Draw award accordingly.
