ORDER BELOW EXH.1 in M.A.C.P No.12/2021

- 1) The matter is kept before Lok-Adalat dt.14/12/2024. The petitioners and their advocate is present. Respondent No.3 Insurance Company authorized its advocate to enter into compromise on its behalf vide authority letters Exh.50 and Exh.51.
- 2) The matter is settled between the petitioners and respondent No.3 Insurance Company, in view of the terms and condition mentioned in Exh.53.
- 3) The respondent No.3 is directed to pay an amount of Rs.3,50,000/- as compensation to the petitioners including the amount of N.F.L. costs, interest, court expenses etc. The said compromise is partly settlement of the claim.
- 4) An amount, Rs.2,25,000/- be paid to petitioner No.1, Rs.1,00,000/- to petitioner No.2 and Rs.25,000/- to petitioner No.3. Out of the share of petitioner No.1, an amount of Rs.50,000/- be fixed in Nationalised bank for the period of three years.
- 5) Claim against respondent Nos.1 and 2 is waived.
- 6) Claim to proceed against respondent Nos.4 to 7 only.
- 7) The amount of compensation be deposited in Court within 60 days, in default, respondent No.3 shall pay interest at the rate of 8% p.a. from the date of order till realization of the amount.
- 8) The respondents shall deposit the compromise amount by R.T.G.S. or N.E.F.T. into the Account Name : Ex Officio Member Motor Accident Claim Tribunal Gangakhed, Customer Name : Dist & Sessions Judge Gangakhed bearing

A/c No. : 40791205612 having IFSC Code No.SBIN0020023 maintained by Tribunal in the State Bank of India.

- 9) The petitioner shall provide the details of PAN Card, Aadhar Card and Saving Bank Account/s for transfer of compensation amount.

Interim award be drawn accordingly.
