ORDER
(Passed on 18/10/2022)

1. The application is filed by applicant/accused requested for permission to go abroad for the period of 15 days i.e. from 20.11.2022 to 31.12.2022 at Abu Dhabi, UAE for attending house warming ceremony of his daughter's new house. The Ld. APP has filed his say and strongly opposed.

2. The applicant has filed his copy of passport, Adhar card. The Applicant has filed his affidavit in support of his application. The applicant undertakes that he will not commit breach of conditions if imposed by the Court. The Ld advocate for accused/applicant undertakes that he will attend the Court in absence of accused on the date of hearing.

3. Considering the reasons mentioned in the application and above discussions, I come to the conclusion that application is liable to be allowed with certain conditions. Hence I pass following order :-

ORDER

Application is allowed on following conditions :-

1) The accused/applicant is permitted to go abroad for the

period of 15 days i.e. from 20.11.2022 to 31.12.2022 at Abu Dhabi, UAE subject to undertaking that, concern Advocate will conduct case without challenging identification.

- 2) The accused/applicant shall furnish the documents in respect of local as well as permanent address of the same.
- 3) Accused shall also furnish the address of the place of his stay in abroad.
- 4) The accused shall submit before the Court the true copies of his Passport and the Visa.
- 5) The accused and the Ld Advocate shall co-operate with the Court for speedy disposal of the case.
- 6) The accused shall sent copy of this order immediately to concern police station by speed post for necessary information.
- 7) The above permission shall not be used by the accused/applicant in any manner for any unlawful activity.
