**ORDER BELOW EXH.01**

(Delivered on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2026)

The present application is filed by applicant/accused under **Section 483** of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for regular bail in respect of C. R. No.188/2026 registered with Ambegaon Police Station for the offences punishable under Section 143(1), 143(3) r/w Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 4, 5 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956.

2. The applicant contended that, he is permanently residing at the address mentioned in the cause title of the application. He has not committed any offence. False offence is lodged against him.

3. He further contended that, on 12.05.2026 the informant who is the Police Officer had lodged report alleging therein that on 11.05.2026 she was on her duty, at that time, her Senior told her and the other staff that he had received secret information that, Rohit Raj get done the activity of prostitution. Accordingly, they called the panchas and the decoy. The decoy gave phone call to said Rohit Raj. He sent the photographs of girls on the mobile phone of decoy. Thereafter, the decoy selected two girl from the photographs sent by Rohit Raj. He told the decoy to come on Dwarka Lodging and Boarding. Accordingly, the decoy with another decoy went there. The decoy went in said room

and thereafter gave pre-determine signal. The raiding team went at said place. They inquired with the girl. The girl told that, Rohit Raj and the applicant get done the activity of prostitution from them. Thereafter, as per the information of the girl they went to the applicant. Thereafter, they had apprehended the applicant. They have also rescue two girls after the disclosure of applicant.

4. He further contended that, the decoy had not given him phone call nor he had sent any photographs of any girl to the decoy. He is arrested on the basis of the information given by the girl who was found in the lodge. He is not involved in any activity of prostitution. He is falsely involved in the offence. The victim had given statement before the Magistrate that, they are not involved in prostitution. He is arrested on 12.05.2026. the Investigation Officer had interrogated him. The said fact shows that, nothing is to be recovered or discovered at his instance. He prayed that, he may be released on regular bail.

5. The learned A.P.P. gave his say. He contended that, the offence is serious in nature. The girls who were found on the lodge had given the information that the applicant get done the activity of prostitution from them pursuant to which the applicant is arrested. The applicant is involved in the activity of prostitution. The co-accused is absconding. Therefore, if the applicant is released on bail there are chances that he may pressurize the witnesses and tamper the evidence of prosecution. He prayed that, the application be rejected.

6. Heard learned Advocates appearing for parties.

7. On perusal of material available on record it appears that, on 12.05.2026 the informant who is the Police Officer had lodged

report contending therein that on 11.05.2026 she was on her duty, at that time, her Senior told her and the other staff that he had received secret information that, Rohit Raj get done the activity of prostitution. Accordingly, they called the panchas and the decoy. The decoy gave phone call to said Rohit Raj. He sent the photographs of girls on the mobile phone of decoy. Thereafter, the decoy selected two girl from the photographs sent by Rohit Raj. He told the decoy to come on Dwarka Lodging and Boarding. Accordingly, two decoy went there. The decoy went in said room and thereafter gave pre-determine signal. The raiding team went at said place. They inquired with the girls. The girls told that, Rohit Raj and the applicant get done the activity of prostitution from them. Thereafter, as per the information of the girls they went to the applicant. Thereafter, they had apprehended the applicant. They have also rescue two girls on the basis of disclosure made by applicant.

8. The content of report shows that, the girls which were found on the lodge had disclose that, the applicant get done the activity of prostitution from them. The contents of the report does not show that, the decoy had given any phone call to applicant. The statement of girls found on the lodge is recorded by the learned Magistrate. The said statement shows that, they have stated before the Magistrate that they are not involved in the activity of prostitution. The applicant is arrested on 12.05.2026. The Investigation Officer had interrogated the applicant. The said fact shows that, nothing is to be recovered or discovered at the instance of applicant. The say filed by the Investigation Officer shows that, the applicant is not having any criminal antecedents. Therefore, taking into consideration all the above facts, in my opinion, the applicant can be released on regular bail by

putting appropriate conditions for his appearance at trial. Accordingly, I proceed to pass following order :-

**ORDER**

01. The applicant/accused **Sachin Haridas @ Baburao Gaikwad** is ordered to be released on bail, in Crime No.188/2026 registered with Ambegaon Police Station for the offences punishable under Section 143(1), 143(3) r/w Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 4, 5 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956 on executing personal bond of Rs.55,000/- (Fifty Five Thousand) with a surety in the like amount on following conditions :-
- (i) The applicant shall attend Ambegaon Police Station at any time between 11.00 a.m. to 03.00 p.m. on first Wednesday of month till filing of charge-sheet against him.
  - (ii) The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
  - (iii) The applicant/accused shall not contact informant and witnesses himself or through anybody.
  - (iv) The applicant/accused shall not contact with the informant and witnesses through Social Media himself or through anybody.
02. Bail papers be furnished before the concerned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pune.
