ORDER BELOW EXH. 01
(Date :- 02/07/2026)

1] Applicant **Gautamkumar Shaw son of Surendra Shaw** has applied for grant of bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in connection with C.R. No. 383/2026 registered with Hinjewadi Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 75(2), 75(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 67 and 67-A of the Information Technology Act.

2] The Investigating Agency has filed its say and has opposed the bail application. Initially, the victim, by filing her say, had opposed the grant of bail. However, subsequently, she

has submitted that she has no objection to the grant of bail to the Applicant, stating that he did not morph any nude photograph and did not send the same to her or to her husband.

3] In a nutshell, the allegations in the First Information Report are that on 04.05.2026, when the victim was at her residence, both she and her husband received nude morphed images on their personal mobile numbers from mobile number 66803804477.

4]. However, according to the victim, it has subsequently transpired that the said morphed images were not created or shared by the present Applicant, but by some other individual. *Prima-facie*, the mobile number mentioned in the F.I.R. appears to be of a foreign country and not of India. The learned Counsel for the Applicant and Victim submitted that the Applicant is also a victim of an online fraud. According to them, the present crime is an outcome of a loan app fraud, through which the morphed pictures of the victim were sent to her and her husband.

5]. Considering that the investigation, insofar as the present Applicant is concerned, is complete and nothing remains to be seized or recovered from his custody. The Applicant is a permanent resident of Bkari Steel City, Zopadi Colony, Kadamganj Post Simandi, Tal. Marfari, Jharkhand, and is presently residing at Nandoshi, Kirkeetwadi, Pune. Therefore, there is no possibility of abscondence. The Applicant has no

previous antecedents. Hence, the application is liable to be allowed, subject to certain conditions. Consequently, the following order is passed:

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.1) stands allowed.
2. Applicants **Gautamkumar Shaw son of Surendra Shaw** shall be released on bail upon executing a Personal Recognizance Bond and furnishing Surety Bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/-, in Crime No. 383/2026 registered with Hinjawadi Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 75(2), 75(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and u/s. 67, 67-A Information Technology Act on the following conditions:

[i] Applicants shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the present case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

[ii] Applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.

[iii] The applicants shall make himself available as and when called by the investigation officer and attend each and every date of the hearing of the court proceedings before the Court concern.

[vi] Applicant shall submit his photo identities alongwith his contact details to the investigating officer.

3. Bail before concerned Court.
4. Copy of this order be forwarded to the Jail Authority, police station concern and informant/ victim.
5. Intimate the concerned police station, Jail Authority and informant.
6. In terms of above, Application (Exh.1) stands disposed.
7. Humdast if applied, is allowed.
