ORDER BELOW EXH.1

This is an application for regular bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short BNSS).

2. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant/accused, Ld. A.P.P. Perused case papers.

3. Brief facts are that on the basis of secret information about flesh trade at Blue Shark / Moon Flower, Bife Road, Wagholi, Pune. Raid was conducted by sending dummy customer and the Manager and owner of the shop were not present and it was transpired that the accused is the manager of the shop. It was found that some adult females were doing prostitution and the accused was earning profit out of it and therefore, Crime No.240/2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 3, 4, 5 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956 (for short PITA) and Sections 143, 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short BNS) registered at Wagholi Police Station. The accused has been arrested on 20/06/2026 and he is in judicial custody.

4. As per the applicant/accused, the offence was registered in June 2025. He is arrested on 20/06/2026 and since then he is in jail. He is not the owner of the Spa Center. He was doing job of housekeeping and has no knowledge about the illegal business. The victims were major. He does not have criminal antecedents. He has

not played any role in the crime. His family is totally dependent upon him. He is permanent resident of address given and therefore, he may be released on bail.

5. Ld. Advocate for the accused would say that already investigation is almost complete. The another accused is on interim protection. There are no specific allegation against this accused. The offence is more than one year old. Keeping him in custody will not serve any purpose.

6. On the other hand Ld. A.P.P. opposed the application and submitted that the offence is serious. Investigation is still in progress. The accused is resident of some other State and he will abscond and therefore, the application be rejected.

7. It appears that the accused is around 20 years old. He has been arrested almost after one year of the offence. It appears that the investigation is complete. The offences are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. Keeping the accused behind bar may not serve any purpose. Apprehension of the prosecution can be taken care of by imposing suitable conditions. Hence, I pass following order :

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. On executing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- and surety in the like amount, the applicant/accused **Sahil Anwar Hussain** be released on bail in crime No.240/2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 3, 4, 5 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956 and Sections 143, 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered with Wagholi Police Station, Pune.

3. The applicant/accused shall not tamper the evidence.
4. The applicant/accused shall not indulge in similar offences while on bail.
5. The applicant/accused shall attend each and every date before the Trial Court unless his absence is excused.
6. The applicant/accused shall furnish his permanent address and mobile number which he shall not change without intimation to the Trial Court.
7. Bail before Committal Court.
