ORDER BELOW EXH. 01**(Date :- 21/07/2026)**

1] Applicant **Yash Alias Piyush Pradip Parmar** has applied for grant of bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in connection with C.R. No. 379/2026 registered with Hinjewadi Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 75(2), 75(3) and 79 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 67 and 67(A) of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

2] The investigating agency, through the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and the victim have filed their replies opposing the bail application.

3] I have heard the learned advocate for the applicant and learned APP for the State. Perused the record and case papers.

4] It is seen that the present crime came to be registered on the report lodged by the victim alleging therein that the applicant had sent obscene and sexual offensive SMS on her mobile phone containing vulgar remarks intended to insult her modesty and outraged her dignity.

5] It is seen that the applicant was arrested on 19.06.2026 and upon production before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Paud, Pune, he was remanded to the judicial custody and since then he is languishing in Yerwada Jail.

6] Perusal of the case papers reveals that a substantial investigation has been carried out, the mobile phone has been seized from the applicant. Now, nothing is remained to be seized or recovered from him.

7] The offence under section 75 (2) and (3) and 79 are punishable upto 3 years. Thus, considering the accusations

leveled against the applicant, his long incarceration, his young age and as he is pursuing his study, it would not be just, legal and proper to keep him with the harden criminals as his previous antecedents are clear. He is permanent resident of Sakharwadi, Tal. Phaltan, Dist. Satara. In view thereof, the victim's apprehension that the applicant may apply pressure or tamper with the prosecution evidence can be taken care of by imposing certain conditions. Hence, I deem it fit to enlarge the applicant on bail on following conditions. Hence, the order.

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.1) stands allowed.
2. Applicant **Yash Alias Piyush Pradip Parmar** shall be released on bail upon executing a Personal Recognizance Bond and furnishing Surety Bond in the sum of Rs. 15,000/-, in Crime No. 379/2026 registered with Hinjewadi Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 75(2), 75(3) and 79 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and u/s. 67, 67 (A) Information Technology Act on the following conditions:

[i] Applicant shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the present case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

[ii] Applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.

[iii] The applicant shall make himself available as and when called by the investigation officer and attend each and every date of the hearing of the court proceedings before the Court concern.

[vi] Applicant shall submit his photo identities alongwith his contact details to the investigating officer.

3. Bail before concerned Court.
4. Copy of this order be forwarded to the Jail Authority, police station concern and informant/ victim.
5. In terms of above, Application (Exh.1) stands disposed.
6. Case diary be returned to ld. APP for the State.
7. Humdast if applied, is allowed.
