This sessions trial is for the offence under section 307 and other offences of IPC and is pending for last more than six years. The record of this applicant/accused shows that repeatedly he has been remaining absent, and seeking cancellation of warrants, which my learned predecessor have granted in the past on meager penalties of Rs.1,000/- etc. However, the tendency of remaining absent still persist. The last presence as per the record was in 2024. Learned advocate for applicant/accused submitted that he had fallen from railway, and consequently suffered serious injuries and was unable to attend. No papers of this injury or being in coma are filed on record. By order dated 10/06/2026 the bail bonds were already forfeited on observing the aforesaid conduct. In the circumstances, warrants cannot be cancelled and accused cannot be released on bail just because he has rushed to the Court apprehending arrest. Application is rejected. Accused be taken in MCR.
