

ORDER BELOW EXH.37

The applicant/accused Amit Prakash Dagade has filed the application for taking the matter on today's board and has filed pursis below Exh.39 contending that to allow him to go to Abu-Dhabi for eight days in the Month of May, 2025.

3. The say of Ld. A.PP. is called. He has filed his say on application itself and objected the permission sought by the accused.

4. Perused the documents on record.

5. Heard the learned advocate for the accused and learned A.PP. for the State.

5. Taking into consideration prevailing circumstances in the case in hand, following points arose for my determination. I have given findings with reasons thereon as under.

P O I N T S**F I N D I N G S**

1 Whether it is just and proper to permit the accused to go to Dubai, Abu-Dhabi for any eight days in the Month of 2025 ?

Yes.

2 What order?

As per following order.

R E A S O N S**AS TO POINT NOS. 1 & 2 :**

6. The applicant has not mentioned the place where he intended to visit abroad. Subsequently on 03.04.2025 he has filed the pursis in which he contended that he wants to go to Dubai, Abu-Dhabi.

7. Considering the police papers it appears that the accused

Amit Prakash Dagade with other accused persons allegedly committed offences under Sections 307, 504, 506(1)(2) and 34 of the I.P.C. for which C.R.No. 258/2016 is registered. According to the prosecution the accused along with other accused have committed the the said offence with their common intention. The report shows that after the investigation the charge-sheet is filed against the accused persons. No doubt, these offences are of serious nature for which the APP has strong objection to permit the accused to go to Dubai, Abu-Dhabi. He has an apprehension in the mind that if the permission is granted the accused would be absconded and will not remain present for trial.

8. The documents on record discloses that the accused is seeking for permission of 8 days in the month of May, 2025 with an assurance to return to India from Dubai, Abu-Dhabi. He has placed on record his passport which is valid in between 06.10.2023 to 05.10.2025 issued by Republic of India. The accused undertakes that he would return in India from Dubai, Abu Dhabi after completion of eight days. At present he has been enlarged on bail. He is the permanent resident of Bavdhan Kh. Paud Road, Tal. Mulshi, Dist. Pune. At present charge is framed but evidence is yet to be commenced, therefore, I am of the view that there is no hurdle to permit the accused to go Dubai, Abu-Dhabi only for the eight days in the month of May, 2025 on certain conditions. Hence, I pass the following order-

ORDER

1. Application Exh. 37 is allowed.
2. Applicant is permitted to go Dubai, Abu-Dhabi for any eight days in the Month of May, 2025.
3. It is directed the accused that he shall remain present in the court on next date after arrival from Dubai, Abu-Dhabi to India.
4. He shall produce the Air Lines Tickets of departure and arrival at Dubai, Abu-Dhabi without fail forthwith.
5. He shall submit his residential address during the stay as well as furnish the ownership documents before the court immediately.
