ORDER BELOW EXH NO. 01

IN S.C.C. NO. 5430/2017

(Farhad Nuruddin Shaikh **Vs.** Paloma
Swapankumar Gangopadyay Bikram Yoga Hot
Yoga Pvt.Ltd & Ors.)

The complainant is present alongwith his learned advocate who identified the complainant. Learned advocate representing the accused is present. The complainant has filed intimation to withdraw the complainant and stated that the withdrawal is voluntary upon compromise. Considering voluntariness, I am of the opinion that withdrawal shall be allowed.

2. Section 280 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (the BNSS for brevity) provides that, "If a complainant, at any time before a final order is passed in any case under this Chapter, satisfies the Magistrate that there are sufficient ground for permitting into withdraw his complaint, against the accused or if there be more than one accused, against all or any of them, the Magistrate may permit to withdraw the same, and shall thereupon acquit the accused against whom the complaint is withdrawn."

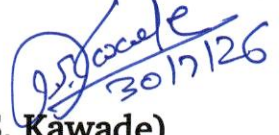
3. In view of the provision aforesaid, the facts warrants permission to withdraw the complaint shall be granted as settlement is sufficient ground for the complainant to withdraw the complaint. Accordingly, I pass the order.

ORDER

1.	Permission to withdraw the complaint is granted.
2.	The accused are acquitted of offense punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 vide 280 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
