This is Second Regular Bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. moved on behalf of the applicant/ accused Sandeep Dahiya @ Baaja.

Heard. Reply of bail application perused.

It is submitted by Ld. counsel for the accused that the accused has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has nothing to do with the alleged offence and make a submission that accused is in JC since 01.01.2020 and make a request that the accused may kindly be released on bail.

Per contra, the bail application of the applicant/ accused has been strongly opposed by Id. APP for the State and make a submission that the bail application of the applicant/ accused may kindly be dismissed.

Having heard the submissions made by Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused, Id. APP for the State and after gone through the contents of the bail application as well as reply filed by IO, this court is of the considered view that the part examination-in-chief of the complainant has been recorded and his further examination-in-chief as well as his cross-examination is to be recorded. The allegations against the accused are of very

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serious nature and if this court allows the bail application of the accused, then, there is every apprehension that the accused may extend threat to the complainant. Therefore, in these facts and circumstances, no ground is made out to release the accused on bail. Hence, the bail application of the accused is hereby dismissed.

The bail application stands disposed off accordingly.

Nothing stated hereinabove shall have any expression on the merits of this case.
