

Order Below Exh.41-A

1. Respondent has filed present application for seeking visitation right of their minor daughter and seeking permission for telephonic communication with his daughter on every day.
2. In spite of sufficient opportunity applicant has failed to file her say on present application, hence application is proceed without her say.
3. Perused application and the record. Heard Advocate for the respondent and the Ld. Advocate for applicant.
4. The fact that Gargi is a daughter of applicant and respondent is undisputed. Similarly, the fact that she is living with applicant is also undisputed. There is nothing on record to show or suggest that the opponents have committed any act of domestic violence during pendency of this application. Since, Gargi is a daughter of respondent, it is obvious that out of love and affection, he would wish to meet her. On perusal of record and application of respondent, it appears that their daughter Gargi is 8 to 9 years old. However, in the interest of maintain the relation between child and her both parents. The respondent is permitted to have visitation right at second and forth Sunday of every month. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1. Respondents are hereby allowed to meet Gargi on second

and forth Sunday of every month between 4.00 pm to 6.00 pm at garden situated near house of applicant ensuring that child's comfort is not compromised.

2. They are further ordered not to do any act of domestic violence during visiting time.
3. Both parties are directed to cooperate with each other during visiting time.
