Order below Exh. 1 in R.C.C. No.747/2013

1. Perused complaint, documents filed along with it and evidence adduced by the complainant and witness under section 244 of Cr.P.C. Heard both the sides at length. Prima-facie, there are grounds for presuming that accused No.1 has committed offences which are punishable under section 420 and 504 of IPC ,which this Court is competent to try and could be adequately punished by this Court. On perusal of oral evidence adduced by the complainant and witness under section 244 of Cr.P.C., there is no allegation against accused No.2. Hence, accused No.2 is deserves to be discharged. Accordingly I pass following order:-

ORDER

1. Charge against accused No.1 be framed for offences punishable under section 420 and 504 of IPC in view of section 246(1) of the Cr. P.C.
2. Accused No.2 is discharged from offence punishable under section 420 and 504 of IPC in view of section 245(1) of Cr.P.C.
3. The case be accordingly fixed for framing of charge.
