	State of Maharashtra Versus Mohan Shankar Dere

**Order below application at Exh.27 dtd.05.07.2025 filed by
Accused namely, Mohan Shankar Dhere.**

Heard both the parties. This is an application filed by the applicant/accused namely, Mohan Shankar Dhere for permission to renew the passport. According to applicant/accused, he falsely implicated in alleged offence. Applicant's daughter-in-law, who is now pregnant, residing at California, America and he decided to go abroad along with his wife Vandana for delivery and medical treatment of his daughter-in-law. Therefore, he filed application before concern office for renewal of passport. But, said office put the objection regarding pendency of the present case. He is ready to remain present in the Court for each an every date. He contended that, he undertakes that he will not leave the country without the permission of this Court.

2. The Ld. A.P.P by filing her say strongly objected the application stating that, the offence registered against the accused is cognizable and serious in nature. If permission is given to applicant/accused, the possibility of causing delay in the trial and getting flee from justice. Hence prays to reject the application.

3. Perused the application and say. Heard learned advocate of the applicant/accused and learned A.P.P. Admittedly, in the present case plea of accused has been recorded u/s.279, 337, 338 of Indian Penal Code and u/s. 184 and 134/177 of Motor

Vehicle Act. Record shows that, till today in all three witness have been examined which include informant and the matter is pending for further evidence of the prosecution. The permission may be granted to the applicant for renewal of the passport. Mere pending of the case will not affect the accused to apply for renewal of the passport. The applicant/accused has filed copy of objection put by Regional Passport Office, Pune and said authority directed the applicant to apply before the Criminal Court where the case is pending for re-issuance of passport.

4. Admittedly certain time will be required to conclude the trial. Considering the submissions of both the parties and documents on record, this Court has no objection for renewal of passport to the accused as per the rules and procedure of the Passport Act, 1967. In the result I pass the following order.

ORDER

- i. This Court has no objection for getting renewal of Passport to the accused as per the due rules and procedure under the Passport Act, 1967 by Competent Authorities.
- ii. The accused has to give undertaking that he will not leave India without prior permission of this court and will produce copy of renewed passport in the court after getting it.
