2] It appears that the notice of the claim petition was served to the opponent No. 2 vide Exh. 9 on 05/03/2019. In spite of it, the opponent No. 2 did not appear and file its W.S. No exparte order or no W.S. are passed. Still, the opponent No. 2 has filed this application for setting aside no W.S. order. Whatever it may be, the opponent No.2 has filed W.S. after period of 2 years. Meanwhile, the Court work was arrested due to spread of COVID-19 pandemic since last twenty one months. Considering the said circumstance and other grounds mentioned in application, it would be proper to allow the opponent No.2 to appear and file W.S. so as to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings. Hence, in the interest of justice, the application is allowed.
