ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

By this application, the applicant being original respondent, has sought to withdraw an amount of Rs.40,000/- deposited by him in Cri. Appeal No. 36/2023, as directed by Ld. Predecessor, while staying the sentence passed by Ld. J.M.F.C., Daund, in S.C.C.No.1179/2016 under the provisions of N.I. Act. It is contended that meanwhile, both parties arrived at settlement and compromised the matter, wherein, Cri. Appeal No. 36/2023, was disposed of and the applicant was acquitted. Hence, he prayed to withdraw the amount of Rs.40,000/- deposited in Court.

2] The respondent/original complainant filed *pursis* (Exh.10) and submitted no objection to the application. Perusal of A. S. report dated 11.08.2026 shows that said amount of Rs.40,000/- was deposited on 26.09.2023, vide 'C' No.33. Further perusal of order below Exh.1 in said appeal shows that the appeal was compromised between parties, and accordingly disposed of, by acquitting the accused.

3] In the facts and circumstances of the case, in view of the order of Ld. Predecessor, amount of Rs.40,000/- be paid to the present applicant on due verification and identification.
