ORDER (BELOW EXH.7)

This interim bail application has been filed by the Applicant/the Accused, namely, Rajkumar Ramsingar Kuswaha in connection with Crime No.998/2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code at Yawat Police Station.

1] The Applicant has claimed the benefit of guidelines issued by Hon'ble the High Power Committee of the State of Maharashtra constituted as per the directions of Hon'ble the Apex Court in Suo Motu Writ Petition (Cri.) No. 1/2020. The learned APP has strongly objected the application by filing say at Exh.8.

2] Heard, the Accused through Video Conferencing and the learned **APP Shri. Vasekar**. The above said offences do not fall under the category of offences which are made exception for granting interim bail as per directions of the High Power Committee. However, the nature of offences alleged to have been committed by the Applicant are serious. There are serious and specific allegations against the Applicant. He is the original resident of Sukhalalchhapar, Post- Mushair Bazar, Thana- Vijayipur, Dist- Gopalganj (State Of Bihar). Therefore, if the Applicant is released on bail, there is possibility of his fleeing

away. He may also pressurize the informant and other prosecution witnesses. His previous interim bail application (Exh.3) was rejected by this Court. There is no change in circumstances. Considering the gravity of offence and facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any reason to favourably consider the application. Therefore, this is not a fit case to release the Applicant on interim bail. Hence, I pass the following Order.

ORDER

This application (Exh.7) for interim bail is hereby rejected.
