dissolution of marriage by mutual consent**

J U D G M E N T

(Delivered on 24th of June, 2026)

This is a petition filed under Section 28 of The Special Marriage Act for dissolving marriage of both the applicants as husband and wife respectively, by mutual consent. Their case is that marriage between them was solemnized and registered on 24.06.2019 under above Act, of which, certificate is issued and they have no child out of wedlock. After marriage, applicant nos.1 and 2 never cohabited together. There was difference of opinion between applicants, and therefore, both the applicants decided to stay separately. At the instance of applicant no.2, a case is filed against applicant no.1 registered as Spl. Case No.222/2020 before Sessions Court at Baramati. Applicant no.1 had filed Spl. Marriage Petition No. 01/2021 against applicant no.2 for restitution of conjugal rights, which came to be withdrawn. Further, applicant no.2 had filed Spl. Marriage Petition No.08/2019 for dissolution of marriage, and later on, she has also withdrawn the same and both applicants have filed present application. There is no possibility of conciliation between the parties. Considering the future of both, they have decided to dissolve the marriage by mutual consent. Applicant No.2 has not claimed any maintenance for herself from applicant no.1-husband. Marriage of applicants was solemnized before Marriage Officer, Pune. Applicant no.2 is residing within the jurisdiction of this Court. Thus, both the parties have mutually sought decree of divorce.

2. Applicant No.1 at Exh.10, and applicant No.2 at Exh.11, filed affidavits respectively, on the lines of contentions and statements

made in the petition and stated that they both have decided to mutually dissolve their marriage. Below list Exh. 13, copy of Adhar cards of applicant nos.1 and 2 (Exhs.14 and 15 respectively), copy of Marriage Certificate (Exh.19) and Notice of intended marriage (Exh.20), showing marriage between both applicants dated 24.06.2019, are filed on record. The case was filed on 21.03.2025. The mandatory period of six months was given to parties for conciliation. Contentions of both the sides have been verified. There appears no collusion between the parties. Conciliation between them and residing together further, appears not possible. Both have decided to dissolve the marriage by mutual consent. Parties are residing within the jurisdiction of the Court. No maintenance or any amount is claimed by applicant no.2 for herself from applicant no.1. Accordingly, the following order is passed.

ORDER

1. The marriage dated 24.06.2019 between applicant No.1-Sunny Bapu Mohite and applicant No.2-Shreya Sunny Mohite shall stand dissolved in terms of prayer made in the petition by mutual consent, ending marital tie between them.
2. A decree be drawn accordingly.
