

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 9**  
**(Dated 21.07.2025)**

1] This application is filed under Section 483 of BNSS by accused/applicant Vishal alias Runal Vinod Shinde. The C.R. No. 877/2024 is registered against him with Daund Police station for the offences punishable under Sec. 74, 78, 351(2), 352 of BNS and under Section 8, 12 of POCSO Act.

2] Perused application, say filed by I.O. and documents produced by both the parties. Heard Advocate for accused and APP Smt. Naik.

3] The case of the prosecution is that, the victim informant is aged 17 years 8 months old residing with her parents and sisters. She is taking education in 12<sup>th</sup> standard. The boy viz. Runal Shinde aged 22 years resident of Ambedkarnagar, Daund was starring her. Therefore, she has reported about the same to her parents. Her parents persuaded the boy and his parents. On 06.12.2024 at about 6.30 p.m. the victim was proceeding towards grocery shop. At that time Runal Shinde had come there, abused and threatened her to come with him otherwise he will kill her. He caught hold her hand and pulled upon his person and thereby outraged her modesty. When she was shouting her mother and maternal uncle came there. On enquiry by them Runal Shinde abused them and left the spot seeing that public started gathering there. Thereafter the victim and her family members taken search of his relatives to give him

understanding but none of his relative has been found. Therefore, the victim has lodged report with Daund Police Station. On the basis of his report CR No. 877/2024 came to be registered. The investigation authority has investigated into the matter and filed charge-sheet against Runal Shinde for the offences 74, 78, 351(2), 352 of BNS and Section 8, 12 of POCSO Act.

4] Advocate for applicant has argued that charge-sheet has been filed and practically the investigation is completed. There is no possibility that trial will be commenced immediately. Hence there is no purpose to keep the applicant in custody. He is an innocent person. He has not committed any such offence as alleged in the FIR. He is falsely implicated in the aforesaid case. Investigation is over therefore, applicant's further custodial interrogation is not required for any purpose. Therefore, applicant is entitled to be released on bail. There is no recovery of discovery at the hands of present applicant. There is delay in lodging FIR. It is lodged after thought. Applicant has no connection with the crime alleged. Name of the accused in the FIR is different than the name of arrested person. The applicant is ready and willing to abide by all the conditions if imposed. He will not jump over the process of bail and liberty given to him. He will not tamper or hamper with the prosecution evidence. The applicant is ready to co-operate with investigation machinery. He is ready to visit police station as and when required by the

investigation agency in order to investigate the matter. Hence applicant be released on bail.

5] The Ld. APP has argued that the alleged offence is serious in nature. If the applicant is released on bail commission of similar offence at his hands cannot be ruled out. The education of the victim will be badly affected. The possibility of pressurising the victim and her relatives at the hands of applicant cannot be ruled out. Hence application be rejected.

6] In response to the notice the victim has appeared before the Court. She has objected the application submitting that if the applicant will be released on bail, possibility of commission of the similar offence at his hands cannot be ruled out. Hence application be rejected.

7] Perused FIR and record. The victim is aged 17 years 8 months old. The applicant accused is aged 22 years old. The investigation into the crime is already completed. The applicant is arrested on 29.01.2025. He is in jail since 30.01.2025. Nothing is recovered from him. The trial will take its own time. The custodial interrogation of the applicant is not necessary for any purpose. If the applicant will be kept behind the bars for longer period, his future will be ruined. Considering objection of victim and prosecution, it appears that it would be just and proper to

released the applicant on bail by imposing suitable conditions. Resultantly, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

1] Application Exh. 9 is allowed.  
2] The applicant/accused Vishal @ Runal Vinod Shinde **be released on bail** on his execution of personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- along with one surety in the like amount on following conditions :-

1] The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of accusation against him, so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to Investigation Officer.

2] The applicant shall not enter in the vicinity of Daund till the decision of this case.

3] The applicant shall not contact with the victim and her family members by any manner till decision of this case.

4] The applicant shall not involve in the similar offence in future by any manner.

5] The applicant shall produce his proof of permanent residence along with his mobile number.

6] The applicant shall give declaration of place of his residence.

7] The applicant shall not commit the similar offence and shall not indulge in any other criminal activities.

8] The applicant shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.

9] The applicant shall attend the Court on each and every date till conclusion of the trial.

10] The applicant shall comply with Chapter – I para Nos. 1 to 6 of the Criminal Manual, 1980, (In view of order of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in Criminal Application No. 28 of 2010 in Public Interest Litigation No. 25 of 2010. dt. January 29, 2020.)

11] Inform to concerned Jail Authority through email.
