

ORDER BELOW EXH.5 IN SPECIAL CASE NO. 222/2024

(Anansabai alias Anusayabai Vitthal Hole Vs. State of Maharashtra)

This application is filed for *ad interim* bail under Section 439 of The Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), in Crime No. 347/2024, registered at Yavat Police Station for offence punishable under Section 3(1)(r)(s) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

2. Heard learned advocate for applicant/accused and learned A.P.P. for State. Perused the record.

3. Accused is a lady aged 70 years, who alone is arrayed in the crime. On notice issued to her under Section 41-A of the Cr.P.C. by Investigating Officer, it is stated that she has co-operated in the investigation and her custody was not required. She has appeared before the Court and filed regular bail application. Accused has sought to release her on *interim* bail looking to her age, ailments and circumstances of the case. Keeping in view the contentions raised by accused lady, as her custody was not sought during investigation and she has applied for regular bail, she may be released in view of the circumstances pleaded by her, till decision on main application for bail. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.5) for interim bail is hereby allowed, till decision on main application for bail.
2. The applicant/accused shall be released on interim bail in Crime No.347/2024 of Yavat Police Station, on her executing Personal Bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and a Surety in the

like sum, till decision on main application for bail.

3. The applicant/accused shall not threaten or pressurize any witness in the case directly or indirectly, and she shall not enter in the area/locality of the complainant and witnesses and contact them in any manner by herself or through anyone on her behalf.
4. The applicant/accused shall produce identity proof alongwith her contact numbers, and numbers of those persons who shall be approached in case the accused is found unavailable.
5. The applicant/accused shall not commit any offence during period of release.
6. Inform Police Station concerned accordingly.
