Rohan Dattatraya Yadav Vs. Shri Vishwa Tours & Travels & Ors.

Present applicants being legal heirs of deceased, have sought to be added under Order 1 Rule 10 of C.P.C. contending that at the time of filing claim petition, they were not aware that action for compensation is contemplated by law, though told by the original petitioner-brother to them. The applicants contended that matter is likely to be settled in Lok-Adalat, therefore, they are sought to be added as petitioners. Application is supported by affidavit. Say is filed by Insurer-Respondent no.2 that all the legal heirs of deceased are necessary parties, who ought to be pleaded, and therefore, suitable orders may be passed.

2] Considering the fact that applicants are stated to be the sisters of the original petitioner in the claim petition which is filed for compensation on account of death of their mother, the applicants are permitted to be joined as petitioners/claimant nos.2 and 3, respectively. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

- 1] Application is hereby allowed.
- 2] Applicants shall be added in the petition as claimants/petitioner nos.2 and 3.
- 3] The petition shall be amended accordingly, on or before next date and copy thereof shall be supplied to respondents.
