ORDER BELOW EXH. 37 IN
SESSIONS CASE NO.244/2024

(Passed on 30.03.2026)

1. Perused the application and reply of Ld. APP. Heard Ld. Counsel for both the sides.
2. Ld. Counsel for accused submitted that accused is intended to go abroad for business purpose. Therefore, he is required to renew his passport. He further submitted that accused is ready to abide by all the conditions imposed by this Court for renewal of passport. Moreover, accused will not abscond. Accordingly, it is prayed to grant permission to renew the passport.
3. Application is resisted by the investigating office and Ld. APP on the ground that the offence is serious in nature. Therefore, there are chances of abscondance of the accused. Moreover, tampering with the evidence of prosecution at the hands of accused cannot be ruled out. As such, they prayed to reject the application.
4. Accused is ready to furnish undertaking to conduct the case through his Advocate and he is ready to present before the Court on the given dates. He has filed on record affidavit in support of his contention. Moreover, there is nothing on record to show that accused would abscond if permission for renewal of passport is granted. Therefore, I do not find any legal impediment to grant

permission to process application for renewal of passport subject to certain conditions for a limited period. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application at Exh.37 is hereby allowed.
2. Permission is granted to process application of the accused viz. Duryodhan Tukaram Bhapkar for renewal of passport in accordance with the law for a period of one year.
3. Accused and Passport Authority to note that no objection for renewal of passport is granted only in respect of crime No. 791/2023 registered with Vadgaon Nimbalkar Police station.
4. Above mentioned period of one year shall begin to run from the date of renewal of passport for which purpose accused viz. Duryodhan Tukaram Bhapkar shall make application within three weeks from today.
5. Accused viz. Duryodhan Tukaram Bhapkar shall not travel abroad without prior permission from this Court to that effect.
6. Accused shall furnish undertaking to the effect that his Counsel shall conduct trial in his absence and he will not challenge his identity during the course of evidence and argument and he will not travel abroad without prior permission of the Court.
