

ORDER BELOW Exh.21 IN RCC No.524/2019

1] This is an application filed by accused No.1 Ramdas Sambaji Pawar for granting NOC for getting passport.

2] Accused No.1 is facing trial before this Court for the offence punishable under sections 143, 147, 323, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal code. From the contents of the application it appears that the accused intends to obtain the passport. He had applied for getting passport from Passport Authority, but due to pendency of present case he is facing difficulty to obtain certificate of police verification. Hence, he prayed to issue NOC for getting passport.

3] I.O. has not filed his say inspite of sufficient opportunity. The APP has resisted the application filing his say and contended that accused has committed serious offence. There is possibility of abscondence of accused. The presence of accused is necessary during the trial. Hence, he prayed to reject the application.

4] Perused the application, say. Gone through record of the present case. Every citizen has right to obtain the passport. The present case is at initial stage. Accused is represented by advocate Shri.B. H. Thorat. The accused No.1 is resident of Kalas, Tal.Indapur, Dist.Pune. There is no reason to reject the application. Accused is ready to obey the conditions imposed by the Court. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

This court has no objection for granting passport to accused No.1 **Ramdas Sambaji Pawar** in pending case i.e. R.C.C. No.524/2019.
