

:- JUDGEMENT :-

1. The accused stands prosecuted for the offence punishable u/s.285 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
2. The charge is read over and explained to accused in vernacular to which he pleaded guilty. I explained him about the consequences of his pleading guilty in spite of that he pleaded guilty. He filed application vide Exh.02 to plead guilt. His plea being voluntary, I accept the same and hold him guilty for the said offence.
3. Heard the accused on the point of sentence. He pleaded for leniency as he is only bread earner in his family and very poor. On considering the facts of the case and poor financial condition of the accused, I proceed to pass the following order.


:- ORDER :-

The accused is convicted for the of offence punishable u/s.285 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 vide Section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.200/-** in default of payment of fine amount shall undergo simple imprisonment for two days.
