- 1 Does the plaintiff prove that, the suit properties are joint family properties of the plaintiff and the defendants ?
- 2 Does the plaintiff prove that, defendant nos. 2 and 3 have relinquished their share in favour of the plaintiff and defendant no. 1 ?
- 3 Whether the plaintiff prove that, defendant nos. 4 and 5 are formal parties ?
- 4 Does the plaintiff prove that, the plaintiff and defendant no. 1 have $\frac{1}{2}$ share in the suit properties ?
- 5 Does the plaintiff prove that defendant no. 1 alone is liable to pay the electricity charges and loan amount in respect of electricity and loan consumed by him ?
- 6 Does defendant no. 3 prove that, the S. No. 266/6 situated in Kasbe Baramati is joint family property ?

- 7 Does defendant no. 3 prove that the gold ornaments and silver wares of deceased Gangubai are in the possession of defendant no. 5 and they are joint family property and liable for partition ?
- 8 Does defendant no. 3 prove that, the property described in para 1-A of the plaint I. e. Gat No. 143/1 of the village Khadki and the property described in para No. 1-A(9) I. e. Gat No. 424/2 of village Khadaki are here self acquired property ?
- 9 Is plaintiff entitled for $\frac{1}{2}$ share in the suit properties ?
- 10 What order and decree ?
