**ORDER BELOW EXH.01**

The present case has been taken up as part of a special drive. The final report was filed by Daund Police under Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, and Sections 188 and 269 of the Indian Penal Code. The matter is currently pending at the stage of prosecution steps. Upon perusal of the record, it is observed that there has been no progress in the case. The matter has remained at the same stage for the past five years, with the accused repeatedly absent. The prosecution has failed to secure the presence of the accused and proceed further. In view of this prolonged pendency and lack of progress, keeping the matter on board serves no useful purpose. The case has been pending since the year 2020. Therefore, I find no legal impediment to stop the proceedings under Section 258 of the Criminal Procedure Code. Hence, the following order is passed.

**ORDER**

1. Proceeding is stopped under Section 258 of Cr.P.C.
2. Accused is discharged, his bail bonds stand canceled if any.
