Perused the case papers. It is seen that the complainant has filed present complaint against the accused under section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act. The complainant has also placed on record certain documents. Moreover, in support of his case, the complainant has filed verification. It appears that, accused is resident of the area beyond the territorial jurisdiction of this Court. Therefore, I make inquiry in order to ascertain whether there is sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused as prescribed under section 225 of B.N.S.S. by considering relevant material on record. After that and perusal of documents, more particularly the verification filed by complainant, it appears prima facie case is made out by the complainant against the accused. Therefore, issue process against the accused for the offence punishable u/sec.138 of Negotiable Instrument Act.
