**ORDER BELOW EXH. No. 17 IN R.C.C. No. 566/2023**

[ State of Maharashtra - Yavat Police Station Vs. Paranali Pramod  
Jagtap and ors. ]

(Passed on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2025)

Present application is filed by the accused no. 4 seeking permission for renewal of passport.

2. It is his contention that in the said matter, chargesheet is filed. He is facing trial for having committed alleged offences punishable under Section 452, 143, 147, 149, 323, 504, 506 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code. At present, he is on bail. He is respectable person in the society. He wants to go on vacation outside India along with his family. Therefore, he is in need of legal and valid passport. But as the said case is pending in this Court, the regional passport authority is not issuing the passport. Hence, prayed for permission to get passport through regional passport authority.

3. The prosecution has filed say on this application and strongly objected the application on the ground that trial is going on. If permission is granted the possibility of absconding of accused cannot be ruled out. Hence, prayed for rejection of the application.

4. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant/accused no. 4 and Ld. A.P.P..

5. Perused the record. It appears that chargesheet is filed in the year 2023. Charge is framed today and matter will be posted for hearing. Accused no. 4 is permanent resident of Pune district. Through this application, accused no. 4 is seeking permission to

apply for passport, so that the regional passport authority can issue his passport. Therefore, applicant is required to move this application. Applicant is only seeking permission for issuance of passport through regional passport office. Applicant is not willing to leave India immediately. Applicant has filed an affidavit about this at Exh.18.

6. Perusal of record shows that applicant/accused no. 4 is consistently present for trial either in person or through his counsel. But in view of circular of, Chief Passport Officer dtd.21.08.2014 wherein it is notified that for issuance of passport to citizen of India against whom criminal proceedings are pending, the applicant is required to submit permission of concern Court. Therefore, applicant is required to move this application. But, applicant is duty bound to attend the Court on each date diligently. Without prior permission of this Court, applicant cannot leave the jurisdiction of this Court or this Country. The issuance of passport does not mean that applicant will leave the Country. In the said facts and circumstances, in order to strike a balance between the liberty of an individual and to secure the presence of accused for trial, by imposing certain terms and conditions, this application deserve to be allowed. Hence, passing following order :-

### **ORDER**

1. Permission for issuance of passport as per rules of the Passport Act is granted.
2. Applicant/accused no. 4 is not permitted to leave India without prior permission of this Court.
3. Applicant/accused no. 4 shall attend each date diligently. The Ld. Advocate of accused no. 4

shall conduct the proceeding diligently for accused no. 4 without challenging his identity after seeking necessary exemption if required.

4. Accused no. 4 to file an Affidavit about accepting this conditions and undertaking to the concern passport office as per rules.
