Perused application and say. Heard both sides. Defendant No.2 has prayed for grant of adjournment on the ground that his counsel has recently received this file. As the record of the case is bulky and there are three connected matters, the counsel for defendant No.2 advocate Shri. Ghare has requested to adjourn the matter.

Both parties are aware that the matter is made time bound by the Hon'ble High Court vide order passed in Writ Petition No. 3183/2008. In this background, it is expected from both sides to take appropriate steps for early disposal of the case and to obey the orders of the Hon'ble High Court.

However, for giving opportunity of hearing to defendant No.2, short time is granted subject to condition that on next date, defendant No.2 shall proceed with the matter, failing in which, her evidence will be treated as closed.

Both parties to note and comply.

Again this Court is requesting all parties and their respective advocates to co-operate this Court for early disposal of the matter, which is time bound and to follow the orders regarding early disposal of the case, issued by the Hon'ble High Court.
