ORDER BELOW EXH-1

Today complainant and it's Ld. advocate have remained absent. Despite the fact that, several opportunities were given to the complainant, but he has grossly failed in it's obligation to remain present, so as to keep the instant proceedings alive. On perusal of the record and proceeding of the case, it is transpired that, process was issued on 27/01/2020. The case is pending for taking steps since 2019 for taking necessary steps to lead evidence. Since then the complainant has remained absent for taking necessary steps in order to proceed further in the case.

02. Thereafter, today also, in spite of repeated calling complainant and its Ld. Advocate did not turned up before the Court, though matter is posted for dismissal order for want of taking necessary steps.

03. Time and again the Hon'ble High Court used to issue directions in respect of disposal of stale and ineffective cases. The present complaint is pending for long period without progress and thus falls in the category of stale and ineffective cases.

04. Considering the above situation, and with the above discussion, I am of the view that, the complainant is no more interested in proceeding further with the complaint. The present complaint is liable to be dismissed. Hence, I pass the following order.

:: ORDER ::

- 01.** The complaint is dismissed in default for want of prosecution.
- 02.** The accused is discharged from the offence punishable U/s. 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.
- 03.** Bail bonds stands cancelled, if any.
- 04.** Case be disposed of accordingly.
