The applicant seeks his release on bail under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with CR No. 186 of 2024, registered with Manchar police station, for the offences punishable under sections 498-A, 506, 504 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code and u/s. 3(1)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. Perused the application and reply of prosecution thereof. Heard both the sides at length of considerable time.

3. Upon perusal record and proceeding it would show that the present applicant was not arrested throughout the investigation. Today the applicants are present along with charge-sheet. The investigation of the present crime is already completed. The applicants undertake to abide any condition imposed by this Court. Except the present case there no appears criminal antecedents against the present applicants. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, gravity and nature of the matter and the fact that investigation is already completed, this Court is of the considered opinion that no prejudiced would be caused to prosecution if the present application is considered subject to certain condition. Hence, the following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. The applicant No. 1 **Tushar Dnyaneshwar Totre**, Applicant No. 2 **Dnyaneshwar Vitthal Totre** and Applicant No. 3 **Sou. Meerabai Dnyaneshwar Totre** shall be released on bail on executing P. R. Bond in the sum of **Rs. 15,000/-** each with surety in the like amount in connection with CR No. 186 of 2024 registered with Manchar police station for the offences punishable under Section 498-A, 506, 504 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code and u/s. 3(1)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989
3. The applicants shall not misuse liberty in any manner.
4. Applicants/accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement and/or influence and or pressurize or cause any threat or give any promise to anybody acquainted with the facts of accusations made against the applicants so as to dissuade such person from disclosing such facts to the court or to the investigating agency and shall not tamper in any manner whatsoever with the prosecution evidence whatsoever.
5. The applicants shall remain present in the Court on its every date without fail.

6. In the event any of the condition herein being violated, the prosecution would be at liberty to seek for cancellation of bail.
7. The bail application Exh.04 is disposed off accordingly.
